DOCUMENTS TO BRING

All interested applicants interested in the United Indian Nations (UIN) WIA Program, are asked to provide necessary documentation which will determine eligibility to enter our program. The following documents must be provided within 45 days after enrolling with UIN. If DOCUMENTATION IS NOT SUBMITTED, APPLICANT WILL BE INELIBIBLE FOR UIN SERVICES.

1. TRIBAL ROLL Number for the BIA and/or BIRTH CERTIFICATE showing American Indian origin.
2. If you and/or your family have HAD ANY INCOME DURING THE LAST 52 WEEKS, PLEASE BRING PAY STUBS or other documentation showing any income received.
3. A document that verifies CURRENT ADDRESS. This will normally be current DRIVERS LICENSE, I.D. CARD, RENT RECEIPT, UTILITY BILL, and OR A SELF ATTESTATION FORM.
4. A document that verifies age or citizenship status. This will normally be a BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR VOTERS REGISTRATION document.
5. A document verifying your STATUS OF UNEMPLOYMENT for the past SEVEN (7) days.
6. A copy of your SOCIAL SECURITY CARD.
7. If MALE, SELECTIVE SERVICE verification for ages 18 to 26 years of age and born on or after July 1, 1960.
8. If you receive any type of public assistance (SSI, TANF, or GA) or UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE, please bring a current letter indicating the amount and terms of your assistance.
9. If you are a VETERAN, please bring your discharge papers or DD-214.
10. If you are PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED, please bring documentation that certifies your handicap (VOCATIONA REHABILITATION, SOCIAL SERVICES AGENCY, VETERANS ADMINSTRATION, and OR A PHYSICIAN'S STATEMENT).

UIN DEFINES A NATIVE AMERICAN AS A PERSON WHO:

- A. *Has a Tribal Roll Number from the Bureau of Indian Affairs.*
- B. *Has a California Indian Census Roll Number.*
- C. *Has a Birth Certificate showing Native American origin.*
